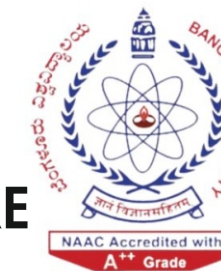

It has been updating its curriculum to the contemporary needs of the LIS professional practices and adapting to the changes timely. Since the mid-1980s it introduced the basic curriculum on the application of computers in library systems and services and today it has developed a good IT Laboratory to prepare the students for the emerging library and information services environment. The Faculty members of the Department have also adopted to the changing needs and have acquired sufficient knowledge and skills for teaching, research in the emerging subjects. The Department is in the forefront of LIS Research with as many as 45 Ph.Ds. awarded during the last 25 years.
